

Massive River Development Plan Hopes to Rejuvenate India's Relationship to the Ganges



Morphogenesis has recently unveiled a proposal for a project that will rehabilitate and develop the ghats (a flight of steps leading down to a river) and crematoriums along a 210-kilometer stretch of the Ganges, India's longest river. The project, titled "A River in Need," is part of the larger National Mission of Clean Ganga (NMCG), an undertaking of the Indian Government's Ministry of Water Resources which was formed in 2011 with twin objectives: to ensure effective abatement of the river's pollution and to conserve and rejuvenate it.
