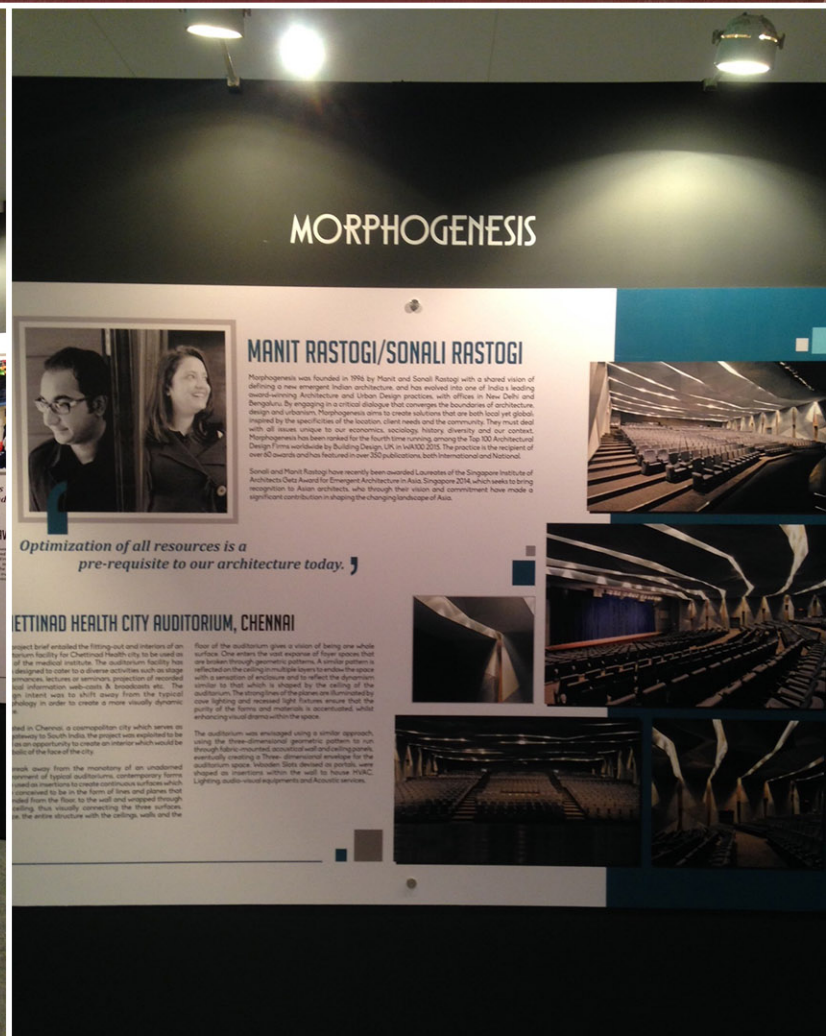

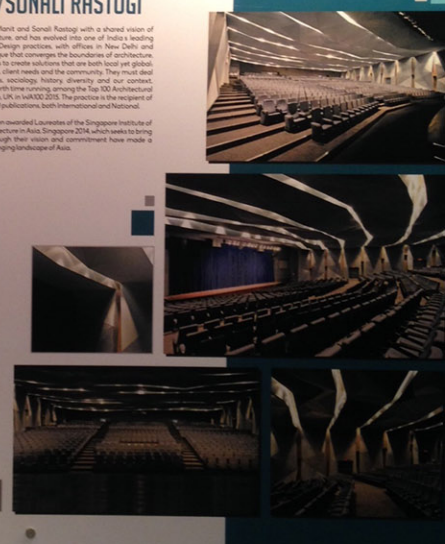

CHETTNAD HEALTH CITY AUDITORIUM, CHENNAI

The project brief entailed the fitting-out and interior of an auditorium facility for Chettnad Health City to be used as a medical institute. The auditorium facility has been designed to cater to diverse activities such as stage performances, lectures or seminars, projections of recorded and live information web-casts & broadcasts etc. The intent was to shift away from the typical rigidity in order to create a more visually dynamic interior.

Chennai, a cosmopolitan city which serves as a gateway to South India, the project was expected to be an opportunity to create an interior which would be a part of the city. The auditorium was envisaged using a similar approach, using the three-dimensional geometric pattern to run through fabric-mounted structural wall & ceiling panels, eventually creating a Three-dimensional envelope for the auditorium space. Selected fabric panels, wall & ceiling, shaped as insertions, within the wall to house HVAC, Lighting, audio-visual equipment and Acoustic services.
